Town of Groveland Water District No. 1 Information Meeting: October 22nd at 4955 Aten Road (Town Hall) 5:00pm - 7:00pm

Dear Resident,

The Town of Groveland has enlisted the help of Livingston County Water and Sewer Authority (Authority) to facilitate a public meeting to inform residents of the process for connecting to the new water service in the Town of Groveland Water District No. 1. The Authority will be holding a public meeting on October 22nd at 5:00pm at the Town Hall, 4955 Aten Road. Authority staff will be available to provide guidance on next steps to residents and answer any questions you may have regarding the permitting process.

A Water Permit Application has been included with this letter and has been prepopulated to include the service address and tax map number for your property. Completing this application will begin the process of connecting to the new water service. Please bring the completed application to the public meeting as staff will be available to review the application for completeness. If any information is incorrect on the application, please advise Authority staff at the meeting so our records can be accurate.

Please note: There will be no permitting, meter, or inspections fees to the property owner as part of this project. However, connection to your home is the responsibility of the property owner by a contractor of your choice. During construction, a curb stop (water shut off) will be installed on your property for your contractor to connect your water service line.

As the Authority currently has many customers in the Town of Groveland, we look forward to working with the residents in the new Water District No. 1.
