The amendment is to change the replacement dog tag fee from \$2.00 to \$12.00; this is only to cover the current cost of such replacement tags.

The Town Board will be holding a public hearing on January 14, 2016 at 8:00 p.m. at the Groveland Town Hall, 4955 Aten Road, Livingston County to introduce a Local Law Amendment: Local Law #1 2011 "Regulation of Dog Control, Licensing & Fees"; The Town Board of the Town of Groveland enacts a Local Law under the authority granted by Section 10 of the New York State Municipal Home Rule and in Section 130 (6) of New York State Town Law.

Local Law 2016 "Regulation of Dog Control, Licensing & Fees" - The purpose of this article is to provide for the licensing and identification of dogs, the control and protection of the dog population and the protection of personal property, domestic animals and deer from dog attack and damage and to preserve the public health, safety and welfare by enforcing regulations and restrictions on the activities of dogs that are consistent with the rights and privileges of citizens of the Town. The proposed amendment is to change the replacement dog tag fee from \$2.00 to \$12.00; this is only to cover the current cost of the replacement tags.
