### Section I.

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to the authority granted by Real Property Tax Law §459-c. All definitions, terms and conditions of such statute shall apply to this Local Law.

#### Section 2.

Real property owned by a person with disabilities whose income is limited by such disabilities, and used as the legal residence of such person, shall be entitled to a partial exemption from taxation up to 50% of the assessed valuation.

#### Section 3.

To be eligible for the full 50% exemption authorized by Real Property Tax Law \$459-c and implemented by this Local Law, the maximum income of such person shall not exceed \$12,500.00. Any such person having a higher income shall be eligible for an exemption in accordance with the following schedule:
