A county feasibility assessment was completed in 2010 that shows Town of Groveland would benefit with joining up with the Town of Geneseo based on the similar properties including Agriculture and Conesus Lake properties.

**Local Law #2-2010**  
**Withdrawal of coordinated assessment program**  
**Of the**  
**Town of Groveland, Livingston County, New York**

**Article 1: Introduction**

***Section 1. Authority***

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Groveland as follows:

The Town of Groveland Withdrawal pursuant to the authority granted the Town in Section 5-G of the General Municipal Law and in Section 579 4(b) & (c) of New York State Real Property Tax Law.

***Section 2. Title***

This local law shall be known as the "Withdrawal of the Coordinated Assessment Program" to replace local law #1-1995 to authorize the participation of the Town of Groveland in a coordinated assessment program.

***Section 3. Purpose***

By adoption of this law the Town of Groveland declares its Assessor's retirement date is tied to the coordinated assessment program and the assessor has given his verbal intention of retiring at the end of his term to September 30, 2013. This would allow a possibility of another assessor be appointed before the expiration of the Assessor's term and other options, without any penalties for opting out of the program. A county feasibility assessment was completed in 2010 that shows Town of Groveland would benefit with joining up with the Town of Geneseo based on the similar properties including Agriculture and Conesus lake properties.

***Section 4. Effective Date***

This local law shall take effect immediately upon the filing of the local law with the Secretary of State to the State Board of Real Property Services.
