## Section 1. Authority

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Groveland as follows:

The Town of Groveland Junk/Rubbish Storage Law is being rescinded pursuant to the authority granted the Town in Section 10 of the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law and in Section 130 (6) of New York State Town Law.

## Section 2. Purpose

The Town of Groveland declares its intent to continue to regulate and control the storage or keeping of junk and rubbish on both residential and commercial properties through the NYS Property Maintenance Law as the junk law is a duplication of what is already in place with NYS laws.

## Section 3: Effective Date

This law shall be effective upon filing with the Secretary of State
